She also wanted to discuss the recent article in the Daily Hampshire Gazette regarding "Possible elevated arsenic and uranium levels in wells" The Board discussed possibly having wells in the affected areas tested.

- 6. Dauchy raised questions about possible excavation at 8 Juggler Meadow Road. BOH is not certain what is going on at this property. Dauchy will contact owners on the Boards behalf.
- 7. Jean Bergstrom 105 Hemenway Road called the Board inquiring about how to go about selling herbs at local farm stands. Steve Ball, HA said he would have to inspect her facility. She might also have to contact ZBA, because of running a business from home.
- 8. The Board discussed participating in the Tobacco Coalition. Unanimous decision to join Coalition. Zipkowitz will sign Municipal Participation Collaborative Form. Clerk will mail to Mary Kresell.
- 9. Fair informed the Board that The Public Health District Planning Grant has been approved. The next step is to hire consultants as project managers to work throughout the summer. After the consults have devised a plan. By the end of the summer the Town of Leverett can make the decision to join or not.
