1. **David Palmer**, present, owner **105 Hemenway Road** well permit application approved signed by Dauchy. Received from David Palmer check# 3109, dated 7/16/2012 for \$75.00 for well permit
2. Received Title 5 Inspection Report from Gregg's Waste Water Removal dated 6/29/2012 for **132 Cave Hill Road** owners **Michael and Margaret Sander**. System failed due to backup at D-box and solids carryover from tank. Received from Michael and Margaret Sander check# 2515 dated 6/29/2012 for \$150.00 for Title 5 Inspection.
3. Hillman moved to accept the minutes of the 7/2/2012 minutes as amended. Phillips seconded. Motion passed.
4. Received application for Recreation Camp from Leverett Summer Camp. Camp operator Michael DeRosa. Issued license# 2012-06. Also received satisfactory inspection report by Health Agent, Steve Ball. Permit Signed by Phillips. Fee waived based on precedent.
5. Received Bacteriological Report from Quabbin Analytical dated 6/6/2012 for Leverett Coop. Absent of Coliform.
6. Received copy of letter from **Sara and Christina Barber-Just**, owners of **5 Still Corner Road**, to Steve Ball, Health Agent, in response to his Notice of Code Violation. The letter indicated that they have cleaned up their compost pile that has been disturbed by a neighbor's un-leached dogs. Dauchy will contact Steve Ball and request that he resolve the issue.
7. Received application for 10-day Emergency Beaver Permit from WMECO. Dauchy will contact Integrated Wildlife Control regarding timing and issue permit when appropriate.
8. **Andy Cole** present representing **60 Camp Hill Road**, owners **Tom Friedman and Mary Ryan**. Dauchy spoke to Doug MacLeay regarding tight tank. MacLeay was going to get a confirmation from DEP. MacLeay verified with DEP that there was presumptive approval of the tight tank. Building Permit signed by Dauchy.

8. Hillman forwarded an e-mail from Glenn Ayers to Zipkowitz and Ball regarding **62A Camp Road** from Tom MacDonald Electrical Inspector stating that he had serious concerns regarding the safety of the building. Tom stated that he would contact WMECO.
