# **Mandatory Inspections**

The following is a list of inspections required by 527 CMR 1.00 or the MGLs, or where it is good policy to conduct an inspection before issuing a permit.

#### Massachusetts General Laws:

C.10 s.74 - Inspections of premises for liquor licenses.

C.148 s.4 - Institutions defined by State Building Code and licensed by Department of Public Health and Department of Public Welfare - every 3 months. These occupancies include:

- Hospitals
- Sanatoriums
- Convalescent and nursing homes
- Public and private infirmaries
- Rest homes (does not include assisted living)
- Charitable homes for the elderly
- Mental health hospitals and facilities

C.148 s.4 - Inns licensed under c.140.

C.148 s.26F - Smoke alarms upon sale or transfer of property (pre-1975).

Inspection is not mandated but is a good practice before issuing the certificate.

C.148 s.26F ½ - Carbon monoxide detectors upon sale or transfer of property.

C.111 Inspections of: (These inspections are conducted at time of licensing). These duplicate the inspections contained in MGL c.148 s. 4)

- Hospitals
- Clinics
- Infirmaries
- Charitable homes for the elderly
- Care facilities for the developmentally disabled
- Rest homes

#### Inspection by the Fire Department

527 CMR 1.00: 1.12.8.51.2 – Certificate of completion for the installation or alteration of fuel oil burning equipment and the storage of oil.

527 CMR 1.00: 42.7.6.1 – Fleet fueling (installations)

527 CMR 1.00: 1.12.8.43.1.2.1 - LP-gas installations

527 CMR 1.00: 69 – Liquefied Petroleum Gases and Liquefied Natural Gases

## Fire Department Issues Permit/May Inspect

527 CMR 1.00: 20.8.2.6.1. and 1.12 – Installation of unvented propane or natural gas fire space heaters.

527 CMR 1.00: 65.9.2.1. and 1.12.8.39 & MGL c.148 s. 13 – Temporary storage of fireworks

527 CMR 1.00: 69.1.2. and 1.12, Table 69.5.3.1.(b) – Storage of 1-pound LP-gas cylinders

527 CMR 1.00: 1.12.8.25.3.4.1—Transportation of combustible liquids via cargo and transfer tanks.

527 CMR 1.00: 65.9.2.1. & MGL c.148 s.13 – Intrastate transportation of fireworks and explosives – There is no specific inspection requirement but these vehicles are normally included in the inspection process for fireworks displays.

### Permits Issued by the State Fire Marshal

It is the policy of the State Fire Marshal to conduct inspections before issuing any permit.

527 CMR 1.00: 65.9.2.1 and 1.12.8.39 – Manufacture or storage of fireworks or explosives – annual inspection.

527 CMR 1.00: 65.2.12 – Dense pack portable firing trailers – inspect every five years.

527 CMR 1.00: 1.13.6.3.2.1 Inspection of equipment for a Certificate of Registration – code required inspection.

527 CMR 1.00: 65.9.2.1. & MGL c.148 s.13 – Intrastate transportation of fireworks and explosives (explosive magazine truck inspections)
