Town Hall Grounds Restoration

Project Description

With the approach of the 250 Anniversary year for the Town of Leverett in 2024, the Selectboard and Administrator would like the historic Town Hall building, which dates back to 1845 and is located in the Leverett Center Historic District, to look its best. Several years ago the external siding on the building and the windows were restored and replaced and the building still looks great, but the grounds around the structure do not. What began as a need to restore the stone wall at the front of the building grew into an effort to restore many aspects of the Town Hall grounds that time has damaged. The lovely stone bench in the front yard has shifted and is no longer level, the stone path leading from Montague Road to the building has compressed into the ground so that rain puddles in it by the road; the flower beds at the base of the stone wall have become overgrown and the flower beds on the south side of the building also have become overgrown. The side flower beds have an additional safety issue in that when they were rebuilt several years ago, the stone steps were not fully lined up with the kitchen side door, which has created a fall hazard. The Town has filled in the gap, but a full shifting of the flower beds would remove the gap. In addition, at the rear of the building, the split rail fence rotted and was removed a few years ago and the flowering tree is no longer healthy and needs to be replaced.

Additional funds have been added to the proposed budget to make sure that new plants and trees purchased are pollinators and are appropriate for the historic building and the New England climate. The town has received an estimate for the completion of all this work, which, if funded, can be completed over the summer of 2023 in time for the 250 Anniversary year of 2024 and the Town Hall, which stands at the heart of Leverett's historic Leverett Center community, will look as good as it did historically.
