## FISCAL 2024 REVALUATION OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF LEVERETT

In compliance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40, Section 56, the Board of Assessors has completed a revaluation of all real and personal property in the Town of Leverett and has received Preliminary Certification from the Massachusetts Department of Revenue for all properties for Fiscal Year 2024.

Analysis of real estate transactions from **January 2021 through December 2022**, as well as regional data, were reviewed during the revaluation. The values were adjusted to reflect full and fair cash value as of **January 1, 2023**. Overall, compared to Fiscal Year 2023, real estate and personal property values have increased 5.10%. Note the actual percentage change on individual tax bills will differ as the tax rate has not yet been set.

The preliminary values will be available for public viewing beginning October 2, 2023 for five business days ending October 6, 2023.
